Guard Your Heart

"Above all else, **guard your heart**, for everything you do flows from it." (Proverbs 4:23, NIV)

The power of your thoughts has tremendous ability to shape your life for good or for bad. That's why it's so important for you to fill your heart with good things – especially the words of God. They bring "life" and "health" (v.22).

King David says, "I rise early... to cry out for help (that's prayer) and to put my hope in your words (that's Bible study)" (Psalm 119:147, NLT). Are you starting your day with hope – or with despair? David says, "I start every morning talking to You, Lord. I cry out in prayer, listening to You, reading your Word." That's the key to start the day with hope.

There are over 7,000 promises in the Bible. If you want to thrive like the "tree" in Psalm 1 – "which yields its fruit in season, whose leaf doesn't wither, whatever he does prospers", then can I encourage you? **Saturate your mind daily on God's promises.** Think about "things that are true, noble, right, pure, lovely, admirable, excellent or praiseworthy" (Philippians 4:8)

Just as the Lord told Gideon "**The Lord is with you, mighty warrior.**" (Judges 6:12), do not allow fear to overwhelm us but hold on to His promises daily to be with us and protect us from harm. And let us also remember Hebrews 10:25, to **continue meeting together** and encouraging one another.
