That's why I sometimes respond "OK Law!" when my wife tells me to do something (Although I hope there'll be more "OK Love" as I age). In the same token, I sometimes find my unwillingness getting in the way of my obedience to God. It could be giving 10 percent in tithe or attending prayer meeting or cell group. So, what should I do? Wait till the LOVE of God hits me before I obey him? Or simply obey the Law of the Word, however unwilling I feel? A sister once shared with me that she too struggled with giving God 10 percent, but she simply obeyed His Law first. Over time, God changed her heart such that she loved to give.

There have been times in the past (and there still are) when I found it easier not to attend church meetings or take on additional responsibilities. But I remember that when the effort was made to go against the grain of convenience, I ended up feeling extremely blessed each time. Over time, I began to grumble less as God placed the right desire and joy in my heart.

I'm not a 100 percent there yet, and there are still many areas of obedience where I struggle with, and complain and grumble about. But...

Consistently praying to God to Change my Heart, regarding the matter of contention works wonders:

“Moreover, I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; and I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh.” Ezekiel 36:26

I ask for Strength:

“Be strong and courageous. Do not be frightened, and do not be dismayed, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go.” Joshua 1:9
